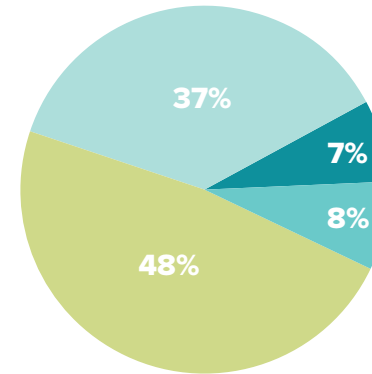


DIVERSE POPULATIONS WE SERVE

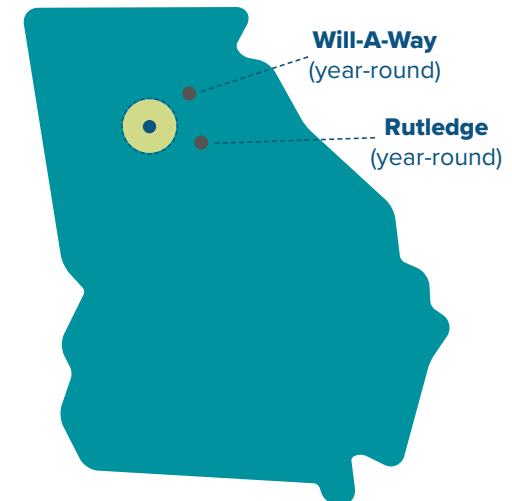
